<p>Evidence/Elaboration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Comprehensive evidence (facts, details) from source materials is integrated, relevant and specific. -Logically ordered reasons and evidence that are supported by facts and details. -Effective use of a variety of elaborative techniques. -Vocabulary is clearly appropriate for the audience and purpose. -Effective, appropriate style enhances content. 	<p>Content Development/Elaboration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Very effectively develops arguments with logical reasoning and adeptly integrates relevant details and/or source-based evidence to support the writer’s claims. -Uses a variety of elaborative techniques. -Demonstrates a very effective style and tone, precise control of language, domain-specific word choice, and an exceptional awareness of audience.
