- ✓ Export your polished document out of CorrectEnglish® and into the format your project requires.

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



Check for Originality

When you've addressed feedback from all reviews of your paper (usually at least 2), checking it for originality will help you assure you haven't accidentally plagiarized someone else's work by forgetting to include a citation.

Click on the "Help" tab at the top of the right-hand column in CorrectEnglish®. Then, click on the "Check my writing" bar to generate an originality report.

When CorrectEnglish is finished with the report, the Originality Report bar will appear. Click on it to see alerts to content that must be cited.

It is recommended that you save the file again once you've corrected any missing citations.



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

Save the file when you have completed your first draft.







Save the file again after completing any changes/corrections you make when following the recommendations from "Fix My Doc".




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
Submit your first draft for review

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
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Review your tutor's personalized feedback and revision strategies

View, reply to, or delete comments.




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
Submit your second draft for review





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
