

Attaching a Resource to an Assignment in Special Instructions

You can attach a link to an assignment through Special Instructions. Students will be able to go directly to the document, download it, complete it, and turn it in.

While in Your Teacher Account:

1. Go to the **Student Resource page** in your **Teacher Resources**

Click on the *resource* you wish to share with your students. Copy the URL from the address bar:


2. Go into your *Prompt Assignment* and click on *Step 6*


At the bottom of the page, under *Special Instructions* type the name of the resource ex: *Narrative Outline*

Highlight the name of the resource

Note: Consider adding grading criteria, requirements, vocabulary terms, source links etc.




Click the Link icon 

Paste the URL for the Road Map in the Link URL area

Set the Target to Open in another window.

Hit Insert.



Students will now be able to go directly to the *Resource* in *Special Instructions*, download it and write in it as they complete the writing process.
