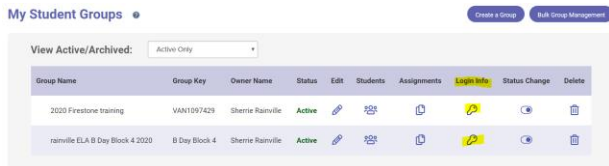


Please note that students will need their User Name and Password to access the program. You will find these by clicking on the key when viewing your groups.

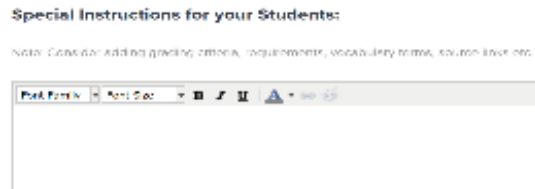


Step 1:

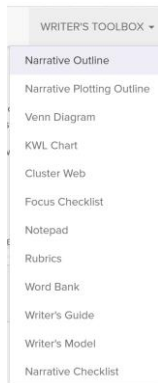
- When looking for a prompt, remember to *View Sources*



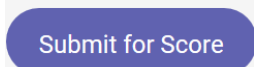
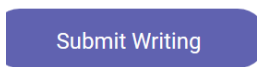
- Teacher assigns prompt and includes prewriting activities requirements in *Step 6 Add Tools* under **Special Instructions**.



- These could include any of the organizers in the students' **Writers Toolbox**.



Students complete prewriting and type and submit first draft

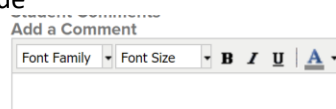


Step 2:


- Teachers use Portfolio to look at essays and send comments to focus students on a specific MY Tutor

domain.  Scroll to bottom of page to reread the essay

- Type your comment and grade

Step 3:

- Students read teacher feedback and use MY Tutor for revision. They will submit after each revision.

Step 4:

- Students use MY Editor

- Teachers use the comment feature to let students know their grade as well as any additional feedback.
