Sample Special Instructions

Your essay will be graded, based on completing the following:

- Strong introduction, with your claim, highlighted in green.
- Three or more body paragraphs, each beginning with a strong argument as the topic. sentence, with a minimum of 2 cited references in each paragraph.
- One strong counterargument in each paragraph.
- Strong transitions at the beginning of each paragraph and within, when noting references.
- Strong conclusion, with the claim as the first sentence.

To include a link in Special Instructions

- 1. Type the URL or name of the site
- 2. Highlight the URL or name of the site






- 5. Set the Target to open in the same or a new window
- 6. Click Insert this is now a direct link. Students can click on it and get directly to the source.
