

# Zapier Integrations

This document serves to inform users on how to use Zapier to connect AMPED with the other applications they use every day.

















## What is Zapier?

Zapier is an online automation tool that connects your favorite apps, such as Gmail, Slack, MailChimp, and over 1,000 more with AMPED. You can connect two or more apps to automate repetitive tasks without coding or relying on developers to build the integration. Move info between your web apps automatically, so you can focus on your most important work. It's easy enough that anyone can build their own app workflows with just a few clicks.

To use Zapier with AMPED, you must first have a Zapier account. Sign up for a free Zapier account [here](#). For more information on Zapier, visit their [website](#).


## How can I use Zapier with AMPED?
