Clicking "Connect an Account" will open a pop-up window where you can enter the required information to authenticate your iContact account. Zapier will ask for API access to connect to your iContact Account. Follow the steps in the connection process to allow this access. Enter your Application ID, API Password and iContact Username/Email Address and click "Yes, Continue" to authenticate your account.
